Junior Flyers - Code of Conduct

Amphill & Flitwick Flyers will provide:

- England Athletics qualified and CRB checked coaches.
- A safe environment during the coaching session.
- Structured coaching sessions with a variety of activities over the duration of the course
- A warm welcome and praise and encouragement of Junior Flyers' efforts.
- Familiar faces each coaching session.
- A designated area for parent's or guardians who would like to watch training in progress
- Access to the Club Welfare Officer.
- The assurance that a Junior Flyer will not be released from a session with anyone but the parent/guardian signed overleaf without prior arrangement.

As a Parent I will:

- Act with consideration, showing respect to others: coaches, Junior Flyers and other parents at all times.
- Ensure that my child acts with consideration to others and follows the code of conduct as set out here.
- Ensure the timely transportation of my child to and from the training sessions.
- Remain in the designated viewing area once the session is underway unless invited onto the track by a coach or in the case of an emergency.

As a Junior Flyer I will:

- Act with consideration, showing respect to others: coaches, other Junior Flyers and parents at all times.
- Refrain from acting in a way that may put my safety or the safety of others at risk.
- Wear appropriate footwear and clothing.
- Pay attention to and act upon coaches instructions at all times during a coaching session.
- Refrain from using phones during a session and/or bringing MP3 players, games consoles etc. to the coaching session.

Please Note: Failure of a parent or athlete to adhere to the code of conduct will initially result in a warning. Subsequent breaches may result in removal from a session or from the course.

Data Protection

Sensitive personal data will be processed and retained securely and in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.
